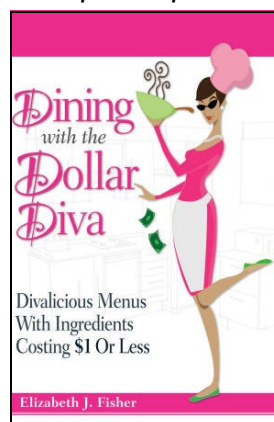


Book Signing (and Tasting!) with the Dollar Diva!
