detective mysteries. Each participants will

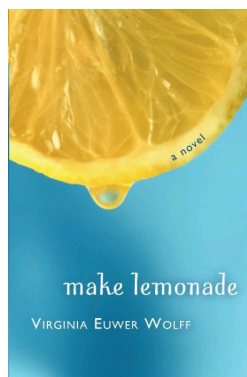
get to keep his or her copies of each title.
