information, resources, and activities available for adults and youth. Light refreshments will be served.

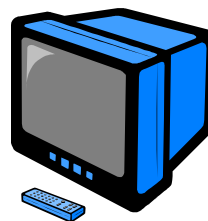


Digital TV Transition
