Patrons practice yoga moves at the library.

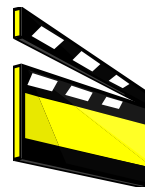
The next Fit for Life program is just for teens. On Saturday, May 23rd from 1-3:30pm, teens can explore development of the mind, body, and
