significantly last year.

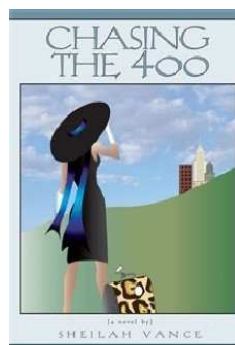
